**PURPOSE:** The purpose of this memorandum is to inform school sites of the distribution of the SEACO Content Standards Guide to teachers of students on the alternate curriculum. Each classroom teacher of students on the alternate curriculum will receive one SEACO Content Standards Guide on a USB flash drive via school mail.

**MAJOR CHANGES:** The new SEACO Content Standards Guide replaces the original SEACO Core Content Access Guide.

- GUIDELINES:**
1. All alternate curriculum teachers will receive a USB flash drive with SEACO content during the month of March.
  2. The SEACO Content Standards Guide contains information intended to help educators more easily navigate and align goals and strategies to the current State Standards and was developed by the Special Education Administrators of County Offices, a committee of highly experienced California special education professionals. The SEACO Content Standards Guide contains information that will assist teachers as they plan for instruction, align content to standards, and write standards-based IEPs.

Resources in the SEACO Content Standards Guide were developed based on the California State Standards, Dynamic Learning Maps® consortium work, National Center and State Collaborative consortium work, Khan Academy website, and the California Teachers Association ELA Spirals.
