PURPOSE: The purpose of this Reference Guide is to inform schools and local districts of the role and purpose of the Children’s Health Access and Medi-Cal Program (CHAMP) office, the 2011-12 CHAMP community partners, and outline the role and function of community partners performing outreach and enrollment services within LAUSD schools.

MAJOR CHANGES: New Reference Guide.

INSTRUCTIONS: I. Introduction

In 2010-2011, LAUSD’s CHAMP office and Healthy Start Programs enrolled over 4000 students and/or parents into low- or no-cost health insurance programs, principally Medi-Cal and Healthy Families.

A. Role and Responsibilities of CHAMP to its Outreach and Enrollment Partners and its Schools

1. CHAMP supports the efforts of its Outreach and Enrollment Partners by:
 - Clarifying district policy and working with Outreach and Enrollment Community “Partners” regarding all aspects of program coordination.
 - Identifying and assigning school sites where Partners can provide outreach and enrollment services to parents.
 - Including Partners in health fairs, conferences, and media events scheduled within its assigned schools that are relevant to healthcare outreach and enrollment efforts.
 - Serving as a liaison between Partners and schools to assist in building relationships.
 - Providing advocacy for overall program implementation.
2. CHAMP lays the groundwork for Partners to provide targeted outreach and enrollment services to specific schools. CHAMP supports schools by:
 - Communicating with each school assigned a Partner, at least 30 days prior to the commencing of outreach and enrollment activities, the

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name of their Partner and its primary contact; how to contact them; and the basic nature of outreach and enrollment. (Please see Attachments A and B for sample documents.)

- Re-assigning Partners as needed, whether at the request of the partner or the school. (Please refer to Attachments D and E to located Partners and school partner assignments.)
- Serving as liaisons with schools to assist in understanding the role and purpose of health insurance coverage outreach and enrollment. (Please refer to Attachment F for liaison contact information.)
- Sharing pertinent information in a timely manner, i.e., changes in Partners staff.

II. Community Partners

A. Rationale for Including Partner Agencies: The District recognizes that more than 100,000 of its students are eligible, but uninsured. CHAMP enters into memorandums of understanding with outreach and enrollment community partners to extend its ability to enroll as many students as possible.

B. All Partners are qualified in accordance with the Healthy Families Program Participating Plan Marketing Guidelines (Revised July 31, 2006).

C. Roles and Responsibilities of Outreach and Enrollment Community Partners

1. Partner agrees to:

- Never charge any fee to LAUSD students or families for services and not use any written or verbal solicitation for self-referral.
- Maintain student and family confidentiality at all times.
- Not use any information learned about LAUSD student(s) or families for personal gain or profit or for any purpose other than enrollment activities.
- If the parents request in-person application assistance, Partner will provide it or refer parents to another District Partner or to CHAMP.
- Assist families in selecting a primary care provider by first trying to identify any existing provider relationship; if none exists, providing them with several options which may include school-based health centers, PTA clinics, and/or community resources, i.e., whichever primary care provider is best for the family.
- Provide follow-up services and assistance to parents during the enrollment process.
- Fully inform families of ALL public and privately-sponsored health insurance programs (e.g., Medi-Cal, Emergency Medi-Cal, Healthy Families, Healthy Kids, California Kids, Kaiser Permanente (KP) Cares for Kids, AIM and CHDP), and health care provider options in accordance with the HFP (Healthy Families Program) Guidelines.
- Contact assigned schools at least 30 days before commencing



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outreach and enrollment efforts. Once begun, all outreach and enrollment work will be completed within twenty-one (21) days. Anyone that cannot be assisted within 21 days will be forwarded to the CHAMP office for immediate follow-up.

- As invited, Partners will participate in school fairs or health events on school campuses and will follow-up with parents from these events to provide health insurance information and enrollment assistance.
- Provide both CHAMP and each school administrator with summary information on the number of students and parents assisted with health insurance coverage enrollment, annual recertification, and referrals to other non-health services.

D. Partners recognize that LAUSD schools are busy communities with many activities underway. Outreach and enrollment is prohibited during the following periods:

- During the first thirty (30) calendar days of the new school year.
- The five (5) school days before and after Thanksgiving, winter and spring recess.
- The five (5) school days before and after a track begins and ends.
- During periods of standardized testing; this varies by school calendar.
- The fifteen (15) days before the end of the school year.

III. Schools

A. Roles and Responsibilities of Schools

- Assign a staff member as the lead contact for the Outreach and Enrollment Community Partner. Contact information for Partners can be found in Attachment C.
- Meet with and develop a plan to allow the Partner to conduct outreach and enrollment activities within the building.
- Support and allow Partner to make short, informative presentations to staff and parents, display flyers, banners and posters and distribute approved materials. Approved materials will typically be labeled as "Teachers for Healthy Kids" or "Approved by CHAMP".

B. Right of Refusal

- A school may refuse the free partnership services that are intended to enroll uninsured, eligible children into health coverage. However, such refusal must not be passive or silent. Please contact the Partner or the CHAMP office to decline participation.

SAMPLE Partner Introduction Letter to Principals

Children who have access to medical, dental and vision care often experience a greater sense of well-being. This translates into improved school attendance and higher academic achievement. The goal of LAUSD's Children's Health Access and Medi-Cal Program (CHAMP) is to ensure that every child in the District has health insurance. Since CHAMP has a small staff, we work with partners to assist in reaching all the District's schools.

The purpose of this letter is to introduce your outreach and enrollment partner for the 2011-12 school year. All partners are current and up-to-date with the requirements related to outreach and enrollment, and a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is on file in the CHAMP office. Partners provide application assistance to families at your school site enabling them to enroll their children into low- or no-cost health insurance programs.

Attached you will find the name of the health plan or agency assigned to your school for the current school year and the guidelines they have agreed to follow. Only the outreach and enrollment partner listed on the attachment has been approved to work with your school. Any agency or entity that contacts you who is not listed on the attachment should be referred to the CHAMP office. Up-to-date MOUs can be verified by contacting the CHAMP office at (213) 241-4293.

Parents can also access the CHAMP toll-free HELPLINE at (866) 742-2273 for enrollment assistance, troubleshooting difficulties associated with their current health insurance, and in obtaining referrals for other health or social services. The HELPLINE is open from 8:00 a.m. to 3:45 p.m. Monday through Friday. CHAMP staff speak English and Spanish.

AGENCY & AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVES MUST COMPLY WITH THE FOLLOWING BEFORE SERVICES BEGIN:

- Wear their agency identification badge at all times.
- Sign-in each day at the main office so that the school is aware of the visitor’s presence on campus.
- Work solely with administrators, teachers, clerical staff, parent centers and parents. (**NOTE: there will never be an occasion to work directly with children**).
- Abide to District Policies and Procedures as defined in the Memorandum of Understanding, District Code of Conduct, and State Certified Application Assistor’s Marketing Guidelines.

TYPE OF SERVICES EXPECTED:

- Distribute CHAMP approved Request for Information (RFI) flyer for students to take home. (Health Plans only) See enclosed approved RFI.
- Distribute CHAMP approved “Teachers for Healthy Kids” promotional materials.
- Attend health fairs, Back-to-School or Open House events and make presentations to parents and families, as requested by school administration.
- Perform informational presentations for staff or parents on **ALL** free and low-cost health insurance programs in which the children may be eligible.
- Offer enrollment assistance at the school site or by telephone.

TYPE OF SERVICES PROHIBITED:

- Health Plans will not self-promote nor distribute marketing materials or incentive items (pens, pencils, posters, brochures, etc.) without CHAMP Coordinator’s prior written approval.
- All enrollment events will be coordinated with school administrators and LAUSD CHAMP office liaisons. No enrollment events will be held without prior approval.
